SNOW REMOVAL AND STREET CLEANING

Snow emergency: Temporary no parking during a snow emergency period:

1. On any even number calendar date, no vehicles/trailers can be parked on the side of the street with even numbered addresses from 6:00 pm until 6:00 pm the following day.
2. On any odd numbered calendar date, no vehicles/trailers can be parked on the side of the street with odd numbered addresses from 6:00 pm until 6:00 pm the following day.
3. The Mayor will declare a “snow emergency period” before the snow event.

When a vehicle is parked in violation it can be towed at the owner's expense.
